To start Task Manager:

Ctrl + Alt + Delete

or

Ctrl + Shift + Esc

or

Right click the Taskbar | Click on Task Manager

or

Start | Run | Type: taskmgr | Click OK

or

Create a Desktop Shortcut to taskmgr.exe

or

Double click on C:\WINDOWS\system32\taskmgr.exe

Ctrl + Alt + Delete opens the Windows Security window if the Welcome screen is turned off.

Turn on the Welcome screen...

1. In Control Panel, click User Accounts.
2. Click Change the way users log on or off.
3. Click to select the Use the welcome screen for fast and easy logon check box.
4. Click OK.
