I am attempting to install xp after fitting a new HDD following a "failure" of the old one. I have removed all of the add-on pci cards so the system is down to the bare bones required. I have been running this version of XP with no problems for 3 years so I know the fault is not with the version

When I reach the point during the install where the "install devices" starts, I get the stop code 0x000000BE. Tried a few options but I cannot seem to fix this problem. The HDD is the same size and make as the old one.
