Whenever I start my computer I get a number of 10020 errors appearing in the Event Viewer. The message given along with this error contains the phrases: "...machine wide Default Launch and Activation security descriptor..." and "... Access control entries are not valid..." I am told that I can fix this through the Component Checker.

This I have tried to do, but without any indication as to what particular component is at fault, I do not know which one is at fault.

Any idea how find out which component is causing these errors and how to fix it?
