```

internal dvd with different type and still fails.
Updated all dvd drivers to latest versions – still fails.
Same error using multiple burning software suites.
I don't do much burning, so it's impossible to tell what MS
updates
or sw installed prior to encountering problem.

Are you burning using Windows built-in software, or some 3rd party
software? Some burning related errors can be avoided by switching to
a 3rd party program.
