Windows System restore only restore system files and minor program files. If you need entire PC protection you would need to use something like RollBack Rx or GoBack. I prefer RollBack Rx because Goback no longer support Vista. Also, RollBack Rx can maintain a checkpoint history with a small amount of disk space.
