No, the left Library pane is generally fixed.

> within WMP's Library.
> Can I use the Library like Windows Explorer? Create new folders in the
> left pane and then move files into them?
> What is the procedure for moving files either from Windows Explorer or
> from the WMP Library out of one folder and into another. I've tried
> dragging but it doesn't work.
> It seems to make sense to "recreate" my Windows Explorer folder tree in
> the Library. Good idea? Can it be done?
