This doesn't seem permissions related, since that would result in a prompt for credentials. Unless a file type is mapped, e.g. .ASP or .PL, then it is considered a static file by IIS. So if a .JPG is handled differently than say .TXT, I suspect that IIS is being instructed to do so perhaps through a filter or mapping.
