i have a home network with a cable modem and a router set up. my pc is hooked into the router and is working just fine. i just installed windows xp on my roomates pc from scratch, and for some reason, it is forcing internet connection sharing to run. when i go to the network properties, it has the local area connection AND an internet gateway that says internet connection. windows won't let me disable or delete this icon. when i go to the network setup wizard, i tell it to choose another connection type, and select hub. a message then comes up saying that this connection type isn't recommended due to security issues (firewall) and it just reverts back to using an internet gateway. i tried setting up my router and using IP addresses and such, but nothing seems to work. he also only has one ethernet card in there. is there any way that i can get the network settings to work properly without using ICS? thanks for any help.
