I'm experiencing exactly the same issue in my setup (below), regardless of Static/DHCP. As far as I can tell, it's related to WPA since the problem goes away if WEP is used instead. Anyone? The repair rarely works. Oddly, rebooting might (3/5 times?).

Wireless Client: Broadcom 802.11g (belkin fd7000 PCI)

Client Box: WinXP SP2 on a generic P4/2.0/512

Router: Dell 2300 802.11g (Soon to go – Miracle if it stays up for more than a day, even with latest firmware. This is a different issue though -- the Dell can't handle more than 1 or 2 port forwards reliably).
