> computers. I have Enable NetBIOS over TCP/IP under the Advanced--> WINS  
> configuration.  
> When I set the TCP/IP to obtain an IP address automatically, all of these  
> problems go away. I have check all of the DNS,IP's, and gateways, and  
> everything there is correct.....Please help!!
