- > *connection for the past 3 months.*
- > *The support guy tried some things but he couldnt locate or start the telnet*
- > *service.*

- > *telnet service I couldnt log in. My original cd is WinXP Home 2002 and*
- > *reinstallation is the last thing I want to do. To think I was in the process*
- > *of downloading the Win update files to get ready a SP2 slipstream CD in case*
- > *of trouble :(*
- > *Could somebody help me out here? Is there anyway just to import that service?*
- > *Only 2 incidents I can think of whihc may have even remotely affected my*
- > *computer.*
