Want to find out more? Get Filemon, Process Explorer, and Regmon (all are free) from <<http://www.sysinternals.com/>>. Process Explorer will identify the PID of the running program. Enter that PID as a filter into Filemon and Regmon. Then just run the program that you're interested in, and see what output you get in Filemon and Regmon.
