Limitations to file sharing

While you can share most files on your computer, there are a couple of limitations:

- a.. You cannot share your copy of most software programs, such as Microsoft Word or Microsoft Excel. You can share files created by the program, but the program itself needs to be installed on each computer in your workgroup.
- b.. You cannot share certain protected folders on your computer. These include the Documents and Settings folder, the Windows System or System 32 folder, and the Program Files folder. You also can't share files from other users' profiles.
