>> >fatal crash on XP Home with a new installation. Data did survive.

>> > XP Home accesses internet via XP Pro and works fine.

>> >2 folders – Shared & user-a – that were previously shared, continue to be  
>> >shared. This is true on both computers. Each computer can access two folders  
>> >on the other.

>> >I have not been able to share any additional folders, including folders that  
>> >were shared prior to the crash.

>> >How should I troubleshoot this?

>> > Make sure that the Server service is started and is set to start up  
>> >automatically: Start | Run | services.msc

>> > If that doesn't help, look for relevant messages in Event Viewer:

Since you've changed computer names, I recommend starting over with file sharing. On each computer:

1. Un-share all disks and folders. For a list of all shared disks and folders, type "compmgmt.msc" in the Start | Run box, click Shared Folders, and click Shares. Ignore any with "\$" at the end of their names.

2. Open My Network Places and delete everything in that folder.
3. Re-share the desired disks and folders.
4. Create desired shortcuts in My Network Places.

To access the other computer even if it doesn't appear in My Network Places, type its name in the Start | Run box in this format:
