Hi,

The user is probably not authenticated by the server. That is why she has to enter the proper username and password. Try testing the issue by mapping a shared drive and entering proper username and password.

- 1.. Open My Computer
- 2.. Click Tools and Map network drive
- 3.. Enter a UNC path of the share
- 4.. Click on Different user name
- 5.. Enter her username and password (don't forget the domain name when typing the username)

After following the steps above, restart the computer, log on again and try opening some other share (not the mapped one)! Does this happen even if you logon to the computer using your domain username (some other user)?
