Many thanks again for your detailed reply.

I am a bit embarrassed to tell you that having re-booted both PCs, the wireless router connecting the XP laptop, and myself, the problem has resolved itself.

The only thing I have changed on the XP machine was adding a registry entry to set the DHCP node type to MIXED, (previously unknown), although this didn't make any difference, (this was before my original post).

I am wondering if the wireless router could possibly be the culprit, as it is the only thing I hadn't rebooted during this problem, although I don't see how it would enable the PC to have internet access but not the ability to browse a local PC.

I have added a second XP laptop which worked immediately as soon as I configured the wireless settings.

So for now everything is OK. I shall certainly bookmark your excellent articles for future reference.
