To answer your question, Samsung is using XP Pro 2002. How do I know if it is with advance file sharing or with simple file sharing?

It looks like Browstat changes again depending on which computer is on first. I don't understand this at all!!

1)when I had Samsung and Tuyetmai on after the Dell, both can't access Family Domain.

2) When I had Samsung and Tuyetmai on before the Dell, the Browsat indicate the Master browser is Tuyetmai and we get error # 53 unable to recognize build of browser master , on both Dell and Samsung.
