One piece of secondary software loaded – Cad application called OrCad

User opens a file via a mapped drive and gets slow application performance

User opens same file via UNC path and get fast application performance

Same scenario but not nearly as noticable in browsing files and such

I've seen a lot of issues with XPRO2SP2 users that complain of slow UNC browsing/performance but haven't seen much with slow mapped drive performance.

Any tips/points to review?

Shut down all non-essentials services and startups already.
