I have a laptop running XP Pro connected wirelessly to a router. I also have a desktop running XP Home SP2 connected via ethernet to the same router. Neither computer has trouble connecting to the internet. The desktop can access shared files on the laptop but the laptop turns up an error about not being able to find the network path. It does not recognise any shared folders except its own. Both computers are running ZoneAlarm Pro and have the same settings. They are both setup to allow the other's IP address. As far as I can tell they have the same settings but one can access everything but the laptop cannot. Please help, its extremely frustrating!
