Create a folder on the drive. I prefer to share folders rather than drives even if there is only the one folder on the drive. Share the folder. Make sure the "domain users" group has full share and NTFS permissions. Remove the "everyone" group from the NTFS permissions. Anyone logged on to the domain will be able to get full access to the files. Anyone not logged on to the domain (e.g. some unknown wireless connection) won't be able to access the files.
