I have a machine that will not receive an IP from any router.

It was setup in one location with a DLink router...IP address was 0.0.0.0  
Tried a repair, and recieved :

The following steps of the repair operation failed  
Renewing the IP Address  
Refreshing all DHCP leases and re-registering DNS names  
Please contact your network admin...

We have moved the machine to aonther location, and it does not get an IP  
address from a Netgear router.

Here is the list of everything we have currently tried

- 1) Confirmed TCP/IP is set to auto-assign for both address and DNS.  
Disabled Windows Firewall.
- 2) Recovered from Winsock corruption (KB811259) article.
- 3) Installed 2nd NIC, 1st is integrated, and same issues.
- 4) Uninstalled Norton Internet Security 2007 and rebooted.
- 5) Repair install of Windows XP Home. It put it back to SP1, but I  
figured it would cleanse the palette. Same issues.
- 6) Reset TCP/IP in Win XP (KB299357)

Looking for suggestions to resolve this short of saving data and  
reformatting.
