hi folks

i've got a small home computer network running thru an SMC Barricade router. 3 are XP machines, one is NT4, they all run either Zone Alarm or Kerio firewalls in combo with the innate XP firewall.

I've downloaded "Spiceworks", mostly as a learning toy, to help me understand how to do simple network troubleshooting. the bad news is, I've never been able to sucessfully "see" the other computers thru my Explorer network window. only the shared folders. and none at all on the NT4 system.

spiceworks asks me for my remote admin priveleges on all my computers. is there any way I can create this type of privelege on the XP/NT machines, to allow Spiceworks to log in to these machines?
