both machines are password protected and dont use simple file sharing.

--> i can only access files on the network if I add his name / password on the local machine, matching the name password on the remote machine, is this the only way?

Summary: I would like the remote user to be prompted usrxname/passwrld instead of having his name/password added to the local machine, now his name shows up the welcome screen.

Is there a way the added name and password added can be made to not show on the welcome screen?
