Can the user name /password be entered on the main pc without having it show up on the Welcome screen?

In this case, you should not create the same username on both computers. Assuming computer A username is called Auser and computer B has Buser.

You will use Auser name and password accessing computer from the computer B when it prompts for the username and password. Or check this how to for more details.
