Recovery "Pro vs. Home

Pro " Boot with recovery disk and point to backup source (or last backup), System state is restored with backup.

Home " Boot, restore to Restore Point x, use NTBACKUP to recover file taken after Restore Point x. System State (I don't know but it's probably 98.6% ok In that I don't know if SS is part of the backup for Home but would be in sync with the Restore Point)

Problem: Restore point x only in effect until next system change such as program install, windows updates, unsigned drive install, etc'so a system of Manual Restore Point and Backup would need to occur after any such changes.
