You need Macromedia Flash Player to be able to see images in some web pages.... the program is a must to see the Flash format in images and objects as well as interactive pages, games and other stuff. You will also need the Macromedia Shockwave Player, and the Java Virtual Machine for other images and page format and for some pages and files you will need the Adobe Acrobat Reader.

For better control over the installation and to have it for later reinstallation if needed you should download the installer and save it to the Hard Drive instead of installing it directly from the Internet. as the download starts, select save instead of open.
