This is the one that chokes the adobe reader when you send it to a printer.

I've already done the homework on this one.

Unless you've upgraded to pdf reader 7, you got an error.

I can't test it now as I upgraded to 7 when I found pdf had upgraded.

It happened both online from the public library, and from my home computer. Before I upgraded.

6.0.1 can NOT read a pdf created by 7.

I even tried it offline. It saves to disk with right click save just fine, just can't do anything with it.

Maybe there's been a fix in adobe 7 pdf maker. This was weeks ago that nothing worked to open it to printer.

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
