Hi Dave,

I would try Safe Mode (from that same menu), then once loaded click start/run and type "sfc /scannow" (just ignore whatever might show up on the screen) and hit <enter>. The power surge may have corrupted the font files, and this should detect and replace them. Otherwise, you may need to do a repair installation as there may also be damage to system files.
