I am trying to resolve an issue of everything on my computer reacting very very slow. I have gone to a number of sites recommended in MS Newsgroups and nothing has done the trick so far. I have gone through all my logs just looking for something that might direct me. I have come across numerous times, files being referenced from my D:drive which was only created when I had to re-install Windows quite some time back. I have just used it for some back up info (or so I thought). What am I missing here? Obviously I do not know as much as I should about a partition. Can you direct me on this?? And look at these logs and event messages to tell me what they mean and what problem they might be indicative of?

Also forgot: I am using Sysinternals Process Explorer. When my system was stalling and task mgr showing cpu usage was maxed I checked the process explorer. One of the svchost.exe was showing to be the process. I highlighted it (PID 692), and among the hundred +/- handles was a line saying:
