> under the AllFilesystemObjects, Directory, and Folders in the Registry.
> In each case, no value set. Although subentries below
> ContextMenuHandlers
> did have values.
> I also downloaded the ShellExView software and installed it, ran
> it.
> Brings up quite a few entries. As the readme.txt file and .htm file
> suggest, I'm
> going thru the various entries, disabling them one by one, then
> right-clicking
> a folder in Windows Explorer. So far, no success.
> There is a Symantec.Norton.Antivirus entry under the
> Folder\ShellEx\ContextMenuHandlers
> This makes me suspicious. Installing a Norton Antivirus update did cause
> me
> problems with Outlook Express. That one I had to walk thru with my ISP,
> EarthLink, to fix.
> I'll keep disabling the entries one-by-one that ShellExView
> identifies, and see
> if one of them is the villain.
> Thank you very much for your suggestions.
