thanks for your reply. Could you point me in the troubleshooting direction? I don't know where to begin, i.e., how to figure out which application is causing this.

You want to stop running programs one at a time until doing so stops the message. Then the last program you stopped is the culprit.

First take note of what's running when you get the message (include background programs too). The problem has to be coming from something on that list.

How often does the message appear? If often, stop one of the programs on the list and see if that stops the message. Try that with each program.

If only when you boot, then stop the startup programs one at a time, until you find which one does it.

A little experimentation should find it.
