Place your memory card in the reader and go to My Computer.

Left click each Removable Disk until a folder pops up with pictures in it. Now you can...Copy/Paste or Drag/Drop the files to a folder on your hard drive.

Once you identify the Removable Drive you can right click it and go to... Properties / AutoPlay tab...left click the "Restore Defaults" button / Apply / OK.

Now when you insert the card...maybe the AutoPlay screen will open and you can choose what you wish to do with your pictures.
