They are in order by last modified listed last. But this is only when viewing the folder that comes up when trying to open a file. In that view of the folder there is no "Name" or "Detail" choice.

How are the files listed? Any kind of order? Are they listed by Date, Size, etc?
If you use the Details listing view and you click on the column header "Name" do you get alphabetical listing? Maybe you do get alphabetical listing but it is in descending instead of ascending order. This can happen by accidental clicking as you work, just click on Name again to change from descending to ascending.
