> Here's what happened from Fri - Today

>

> SAT: Disconnected PC to take to a LAN party

> SUN: Brought back PC, reseated mobo, reconnected

> SUN: When I booted the PC, the CMOS had to go back to default settings

> (don't know why, it just failed to boot). Since I didn't change much

> originally (just time, date, and boot order), I fixed those and went to

> Windows.

> SUN nt: Installed an MMORPG

>

> TODAY: I went to print out a resume and nothing happens. The printer
> itself is fine AFAI can tell (power works, it's in the home position,
> cables are all snug and in correct positions). I looked through CMOS to
> see if I could change any settings for a USB printer, but I didn't see
> anything to be aware of. I deleted the printer under the PRINTER AND
> FAXES, unhooked it (via hotswapping), rehooked it, WinXP found it and
> installed the drivers, and it STILL doesn't work.

>

> What appears to be happening is that the data gets stuck in
> transmission. For example, when I click PRINT, the data gets sent, but
> then it just freezes (so about half of the file gets sent). It's only a
> resume, very small file and was working fine Thursday.

>

> I can't uninstall the drivers AFAIK. No option for it that I can see
> under WinXP (not SP1 or SP2 BTW). The latest drivers are already on the
