| We currently have many Windows 2000 Pro PCs on our network that we are trying to remotely upgrade to Windows XP Pro. Before the upgrade everything works properly in Windows 2000, but after the upgrade we are unable to use "Connect Network Registry" to connect to the PCs registry remotely. We can connect to the PC registry via Desktop Connection and edit the registry that way, but there are times when we need to make a change to the registry with the user still logged in. We do not have this problem when we do a clean install of XP, so that this is caused by some setting that is not properly migrated to XP. I have searched many places but have been unable to locate a fix for this issue. Any ideas would be greatly appreciated.
