> C:\i386 doesn't work, and SP1 is no longer available for download
> so that I might burn a CD of it. Can anyone help?

Not that I think the file alone will solve your issue.. (Likely need to make a Windows XP CD with SP1 integrated in it – although that seems weird if you had SP2 installed – I think you need an XP CD with SP2 integrated personally – but...)
