- Are there any bent pins or loose cables/connections from it to the controller/power?
- Do you see it as a drive letter in Windows?
- If *so* - can you read ANY CDs - even original store-bought STAMPED (not burned) ones?
- If *not* - have you recently installed/uninstalled any cd writing utilities or the likes?
- What is the make/model of the drive?
- Is it capable of writing to CDs?
- Do you have the latest firmware for it?
