Hi,

The most common winnt.sif file people tend to use is:

```
[SetupData]
```

```
BootDevice = " ramdisk(0)"
```

```
BootPath = " \I386\System32\"
```

```
OsLoadOptions = " /noguiboot /fastdetect /minint /rdexportascd  
/rdpath=winpex86.iso"
```

Does anyone know how to get WinPE to load into RAM and boot successfully without having to have the BootPath point to i386? That is, can I call the folder containing the following files something else (like minint, or PEboot):

Bootfix.Bin

NTDetect.Com

Setupldr.Bin

Any ideas how to get this working? I've tried various permutations and only ever end up with a blank screen with a flashing cursor...
