Hi Folks,

I'm trying to create a Kaspersky Rescue Disk. One of the things required to do this is a Windows XP Service Pack 2 installation CD. All I have to do is to point Kaspersky to the location of this CD in my PC. The CD is in my E drive, so Kaspersky is pointed to my E drive. Unfortunately, when I run the Kaspersky wizard, I get a message saying "Cannot find Microsoft Windows XP distributive". Does that mean the CD I have is the wrong one? It is clearly marked "Microsoft Windows XP Service Pack 2 with Advanced Security Technologies". It is dated 2004 and carries Part No. X10-80291. I'm thoroughly confused.

Can anyone help?
