Go to a command prompt and type in the following

```
c:\>netstat -na |more
```

It should display what IP addresses and ports your machine is mapping.

Something like this:

Look for the one that says 3389 like what I have above. Is it listed on yours? Is it listening? If it's not listed then TS isn't running. Let me know.
