We have recently begun using offline folders (offline files) and all seems to be working well. The issue is that we are seeing some empty folders on our laptops when not connected.

For example I might choose R:\FolderA\SubA\A.doc to sync.

I see this folder structure and file when offline.

However I also see R:\FolderB\SubB\ ... but I have no recollection of syncing this folder. Furthermore there is no "synced" icon next to the folders.

Also when I right click on them, the Make Available Offline is unchecked.
