I have a windows 2000 domain controller. I create domain users with enabling the option of "User must change password at the next logon". So that the user is prompted and can have his own customised password.

While I try to login from a workstation (windows 2000 professional /windows XP) the system doesnot allow me to login.If I remove that option I could login to the system with the old assigned password.

I tried to login from a windows 2003 server to the domain controller and to my surprise it does ask to change the password.
