The normal behavior is that user's temporary Internet files are stored under his/her own profile area. But on some of the XP Pro workstations, we found that they are stored under the root of C: that are shared by all users. Is there a way to change this to its normal behavior via GP? [...]

You can hardcode it with a tattooing ADM Template and define the default path.
