I just installed Windows 2003 and activated Active Directory.  
Now I want to change the Account policies (the password rules), but everything is greyed out. I am not able to modify those rules.  
But I am logged in as administrator.

What are your attempts for altering the password policies? Did you try to alter them in "Active Directory Users and Computers" at the Default Domain Policy"?

I am running gpedit.msc, then choose the account policies from the Security Settings of the Computer Configuration. The maximum password age is 42, and I want a longer period.
