Hi

There is a need for me to restrict certain access to the PC used by the users, since these PCs are connected to AD, I restricted lot of access through GPO. This includes, USB Storage access, hide C:, A: and D: drive etc

The objective is, I want the user to restrict file copy to this PC, whatever file they create those files should be stored in the network drive only.

Now the challenge is, while I hidden the c:\ drive etc, they are anyway forced to store file on the network drive. These users are using Windows XP, hence they are able to store their file in C:\documents & settings\Username\Desktop.

My question is how to restrict user from copying the files in the desktop, through GPO
