As you can tell from the policy name that it is intended to be applied to my Citrix servers so I have it linked to an OU that contains my Citrix servers and the Security Filtering is applied to my AD group of Citrix Users.

Since you're linking the policy to an OU full of machines and configure CComputer Configuration settings, why would you only allow user accounts access to the policy? The Citrix servers need to be able to read and apply the policy. They need "Read" and "Apply Group Policy" permissions.
