The default domain
controller policy is linked to
the domain
controllers OU and applies
to the DC's located in it,
with
computer
configuration. In this policy
you should basically
NEVER change
anything. If you need
additional settings for the
DC's create a
new
policy and link it also to the
DC's OU. If something fails
you
have
still the basic default
settings for the DC if you
remove your
additional linked GPO's.
If you like to assign a new
software for new
users/computers you
have
to link the policy to the OU
where either the users or
computer
are
added.
