Subject: I have a very annoying problem. I'm not sure how to explain it.

Here's an example of the problem.

Say I'm reading some news article, I open up a new web page to go to a different site, when the new page gets down loading it switches me from my current page to the new page I opened.

So it is not going over the existing page, but switching to the newly opened page. This is very annoying when I have multiple sites, or a site that refresh every so often and I'm reading an article.

Solution: I had the same problem after installing iMesh. Even after the removal of it, that irritating behavior was still persistent. Upon doing a dump of all dlls in use, I found that there was a DLL called VX2.dll which was like a defunct process, not being used at all, so all I did was:
regsvr32 /u VX2.dll
