The situation...

IE6 seems intent on sending clear text password to certain URLs – As reported by ZoneAlarm (ZA) in a "ID Lock Alert" popup. This can happen many times (nine on one site).

The password is for eBay. On ZA's Overview->Preferences tab under "eBay Protection Profile" eBay is listed as a Security Alliance Partner.
