Did you check for spyware using Ad-Aware, SpyBot, CWShredder, and HijackThis?

Do you have a popup blocker?

Same problem occur if you have scripts disabled in the Internet security zone? Could be the sites you are visiting link to pages that use a script timer that will close the child windows for the browser. You could also try disabling the meta refresh option in the security settings since that it also a timer to display another page (which might use a script to close that window).

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
